



## The Parish Council

There are some 9,000 Parish and Town Councils in England. They form the tier of local government which should be closest to the people. Elected every four years, the number of members depends on the size of the electorate. In Quainton there are up to seven and they elect their own chairman annually. Councillors have a statutory code of conduct to follow. Meetings, held on the second Thursday of each month, are open to the public who may only speak with the permission of the chairman, although the opening quarter of an hour of each Quainton meeting is there for the use a public forum. We do ask people wishing to use this facility notify the clerk some days before the meeting.

The agenda for each meeting must be publicly displayed some days prior to the occasion. For this purpose we use the notice board at the bottom of the Green, where you will also find minutes of the previous meeting and details for contacting the clerk or council members. There has to be an annual parish meeting, open to all, where an outline of the Council's activities during the preceding year must be given. Parishioners are able to address this meeting on issues of local concern. Annually, in November/December, we will settle our budget for the financial year ahead and this sum per household is collected via the council tax bill.

Although any parish council has limited legal powers it is the statutory representative of the community and must be consulted on planning matters. The council is also called on by other organisations, such as district and county councils, police and health authorities and other public bodies, to give opinions on a variety of matters affecting its community. Essentially parish councils are charged with looking after community buildings, open spaces, recreational areas, street lighting and some litter clearance, as well as providing allotments. They will also want to pursue any relevant issues they are persuaded would benefit residents. They may spend a limited sum of money on any purpose which, in their opinion, is of direct benefit to their area or residents.

We are keen to hear your wishes and views. We will do our best to maintain Quainton as a happy and caring community, which is why we continued to challenge the many problems to our environment caused by the construction work for HS2, various proposals for large housing estates in the surrounding countryside, including a possible new city. To this end we will be looking to our Neighbourhood Plan which was strongly approved by a referendum of residents and accepted by our then local District Council.

# **Quainton and the Village Society**

Quainton, with a modern population of about 1,300, was almost certainly a settlement of sorts during the Roman occupation. This was probably situated in the Carter's Lane area at the parish's eastern boundary along the Roman Road leading from Fleet Marston to Thornborough. The village name means land owned by a queen. Quainton was probably part of the dowry given to Alhflaed, first queen of Mercia, on the occasion of her marriage to King Peada at Leicester in the year 653.

The Domesday survey of 1086 tells us that there were three principal manors in the parish which remain identifiable to this day, at Denham, Shipton Lee and Doddershall.

The present township has a village green with the remains of a stone cross. There is a medieval church, rectory, Baptist chapel, tower windmill, and a mix of housing from timber-framed 17th century black-and-white thatched cottages, Georgian farmhouses, Victorian terraces and modern properties. There is also a school, a public house and coffee shop and a Village Store - not forgetting the Buckinghamshire Railway Centre on the outskirts.

Quainton Village Society (QVS) was formed as a local amenity society in 1989 "to support the preservation of existing features of historical merit or public interest, and to encourage high standards in new developments in the village".

The committee looks at all relevant planning applications and considers the views of local residents; the role of the Society, in this context, is separate from but complementary to the Parish Council.

The Society also promotes knowledge of the history, geography and architecture of the parish through a number of publications and it holds a small archive of photographs, maps and other material associated with the village.

QVS co-sponsors this Village Directory, and publishes a Village Guide, giving a background to the village, its history and present day features. The Society's overall objectives are

To promote and safeguard the quality of life in the village

To steward and conserve the village's history

To assist other organisations or initiatives that achieve these objectives QVS aims to be a positive and valued component of village life with a central or supportive role in a wide range of events, activities and functions, viewed as an umbrella group caring about Quainton and co-working or networking with other groups or people in Quainton.

# **Quaintwood Players**

It was some years prior to the Second World War that the Women's Institute in Quainton, largely owing to the enthusiasm of their then president, Lady Brown of Doddershall House, great grandmother of the present owner David Prideaux, became involved in presenting plays. Using her contacts, Lady Brown was able to arrange for some productions to be directed by professionals such as Peter Jesson, an actor in *Z Cars*, *Danger Man* and several 'Carry On' films; Mrs Cobden-Sanderson, a captivating story-teller, and Mrs Collingwood-Selby. The latter also directed at the Minack Theatre in Cornwall and her sister lived at Waterperry House where there is a theatre similar to the Minack. This is apparently still used during the annual Waterperry Arts Festival held in the beautiful grounds there.

Under Lady Brown's patronage the Group would often visit Doddershall for dinners and other functions. After her death directors had to be found from their own membership and there was an eventual split from the W.I. in order to stage plays unrestricted by the rule which forbade casts with more than 25% male actors!

For nearly seventy years, first as a W.I. organisation and then as Quainton Drama Group, there was at least one annual production, usually a play, broadening into two, one play and one fund raiser, Victorian Music Hall or Pantomime, each year. Membership was not restricted to Quainton parishioners so friends and workmates from other areas were roped in to help out.

In the last decade of the twentieth century some Grendon Underwood friends with theatrical interests started to stage their own plays, some of them also participating in Quainton where numbers were lessening. Sharing of lighting, scenery and storage had also become a mutually beneficial process. Thus it was decided, in separate votes by the two independent groups, that there would be many advantages in amalgamating. 1999 saw the inauguration of Quaintwood Players, with the clear intention of staging each production in each village, something to which we have remained faithful.

Presently there are 2 or 3 productions each year, typically a pantomime or variety show alternatively, a murder mystery and a full length play. We continue to broaden our range as membership interests and abilities change. Shakespeare's 'A Midsummer Night's Dream', performed locally out and indoors, as well as seeing us chosen as one of the six amateur groups invited by the Royal Shakespeare Company to present an extract onstage in Stratford, was our first production of a work by the bard. Other challenges we have undertaken include plays by Ayckbourn, where the set for 'Bedroom Farce' required three bedrooms simultaneously onstage, and Schaffer's 'Black Comedy' where the cast must act as if in darkness though the stage is lit. 'Stepping Out' and 'Slice of Saturday Night' involved musical skills and our repertoire of murder mysteries continues to extend, with local fund raisers, in the area and wider afield, making regular use of such productions.

We meet weekly, on Mondays, from 8 p m, in Grendon Underwood Village Hall, where there is the convenience of a permanent stage, so do come and give us the once over, whether you aim just to be a supporter, backroom person or have stage ambitions. We appreciate that often people assume a Drama Group will be a clique so fight shy of turning up unannounced but we are as assorted a group as you will find anywhere so do not hesitate to come along. Contact Jackie Giblin on 651835 or Arthur Evans on 655381 and meet other members in your locality to help you 'break the ice', or just turn up one Monday. We are an adult group with children participating in some of our shows when, for child protection purposes, we ask a parent to be present for rehearsals. We look forward to seeing you.





#### **Quainton Oil Group**

The Quainton Oil Group is an association of villagers who seek to obtain discounts on their purchases of heating oil by co-ordinating their orders and delivery dates. The area covered by the Oil Group coincides with circulation area of Quainton News and the means of communication between the co-ordinator and other members of the group is that magazine although there is now an e-mailing group available for those who wish to be contacted that way. Currently there are almost 200 household in the group.

The present oil supplier is Lovell Fuels Ltd of Long Crendon so it is a local company.

The price charged is based on the wholesale price of oil (Platt's index for those who know about such things) on the Friday before delivery plus 5.5p per litre. This price is always competitive and for small users – less than 1000 litres – the price has always bettered the online suppliers. Any members of the group who requires oil at a time other than one of the pre-arranged dates will be given the best available rate but not the full discount. Each group member must set up their own account with Lovell's.

Members of the group fall into one of three user categories: Light users, who receive two deliveries a year; normal users who get three; heavy users who get four. The most appropriate group for a new user will depend upon their usage and the size of their tank. There is a minimum delivery of 250 litres. Anyone wishing to join the group should contact Lovell's and agree payment details and the usage category into which they fall.


