Looking out of the window at the sunshine on the garden and the hill behind, I saw insects, birds, small animals and a fox, all going about their normal lives, and it hit me again that, while we have shut our lives down over Covid, the natural world has continued to go on for us to appreciate – Thank Goodness!!

So - we are very fortunate that the naturalist, **John Tyler**, has agreed to give our Autumn talk.



John has visited us twice before and his presentations were so well received that we were asked to get him back again as soon as possible!

This time, his subject will be **The Ridgeway**, which can claim to be one of the oldest trackways in Europe, stretching nearly ninety miles from lvinghoe to Avebury and over 5,000 years from the Stone Age to the present day. This talk offers a blister-free walk along this ancient chalkland path, describing both its prehistory and the rich wildlife that it supports today.

John's talk, in the main hall of Quainton's Memorial Hall, will start at 7.45pm on 12 October 2021 and precede our AGM for those who wish to attend.

As usual, wine and refreshments will be available from the start of the evening at 7.30pm and we very much look forward to your support and company in joining us for a fascinating and enjoyable evening. I can't believe that the last time that we had the chance, for all of us to get together, was on 10 March 2020 – 18 months ago!! – when Gill Tierney packed the Hall for her talk on Antiques Roadshow and her other programmes.

Please put the date in your diary and help us fill that Hall again!
